**Condition:** Section 11A of the Liquor Act 2007 applies to this licence. Liquor must not be sold by retail on the licensed premises for a continuous period of 6 hours between 04:00AM and 10:00AM during each consecutive period of 24 hours. The licensee must comply with this 6-hour closure period along with any other limits specified in the trading hours for this licence.

b) All alcoholic drinks including RTDs or pre mixed containing alcohol will be mid strength. Any alcoholic branded drinks must have an alcohol content of 4% or less. In this condition ready to drink RTD beverage means an alcoholic mixed beverage that is prepared by the manufacturer.  
c) Any full strength wine supplied and consumed at the function must not exceed 14.5% alcohol content and the bottle must not contain a total alcohol content or more than 10 standard drinks  
d) Drinking vessels used to serve wine at the event must not contain more than 150mls of wine.
